## Important Notes:-

- 1. Maximum Skaters allowed in each Age Group from each State/U.T. each in both Boys and Girls individual events are 3 per age group for all events
- 2. Maximum entries allowed in all age groups from each state / UT for Pair Skating as well as Couple Dance are 3 per age group
- 3. Quartet team will be of 4 skaters
- 4. Small Show Group Team 6 to 12 skaters for 7 to 9, 9 to 11 and 11 to 14 years group, Junior Show Group Team: 8 to 16 skaters for all age groups above 14 years





- 5. Precision Team of 8 to 16 skaters in 14 to 17 and above 17, 8 to 12 Skaters in 11 to 14 and 8 skaters in 9 to 11 age group, and 6 skaters below 9
- 6. From each Unit, for all Age groups skaters can take part in any 4 out of 6 events
- 7. From each Unit, Cadet, Subjunior, Junior and Senior Age groups skaters can additionaly take part in the Team Events
- 8. For all Team events, the event will be conducted only if there are 2 and more teams participating. The minimum marks criteria will be applicable for awarding medals
- 9. Maximum Two teams are allowed in each Age Group from each State/U.T. for all Team Events
- 10. For Cadet and Juniors Minimum marks required for qualifying for International events will be: Cadet (Asians) 4.5 Marks, Junior 5.0 and Seniors 6.0
- 11. From 2020 Nationals a State Association that will enter a Male athelete in the Solo Dance Category whether he is a junior or Senior, will have to enter also a Dance Couple in the same category. This is inline with the upcoming World Skate rule announced.
- 12. From 2020 Nationals each State should compulsarily send a minimum of 2 pairs in total
- 13. For Pair Skating the Girl could be in the same age group or 1 lower age group as compared to the boy
- 14. In rules circulated 11 to 14 Solo Dance the cluster shouls be a maximum level 3 and not level 1 as mentioned.
- 15. The Dance requirements will change every year based on World skate requirement.
- 16. For 57th Nationals, Precision and show group events two teams of Combined Cadet age group, and two team combined Sub Junior and Junior age groups, will be permitted, but they will be awarded certificates in their respective age groups. However from 2020 Nationals it will be by age group
